DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: DUSTY LAKE REHABILITATION PROGRAM TO REMOVE ILLEGAL FISH STOCKING

Description of Proposal: Proponent proposes to rehabilitate Dusty Lake, by the use of Rotenone, to improve fishing for game fish via the elimination of illegally introduced fish species. Dusty Lake has been illegally stocked with speckled dace and most recently, goldfish. In order to eliminate both the speckled dace and goldfish, Rotenone will need to be applied in greater amounts than was originally anticipated. Concentration of Rotenone to be used will be 4 ppm. To treat Dusty Lake's 56 acres a total of 28,000 pounds, 30 gallons, will be applied.
