Description of DNS: Plant triploid (sterile) grass carp into three ponds at Green #1, Green #15 and Green #17, with no public access, to control aquatic vegetation. Future restocking may be necessary due to fish loss.

To: Pierce County; Part of **Sections 19** and 30, **Township 22 North**, Range 02 East WM


