**MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Name of Proposal:** DOGFISH CREEK CULVERT CLEANING

**Description of Proposal:** The proponent plans on removing 90 yards of debris at the inlets and outlets of two culverts named Drainage Systems A and B. Future cleanout may be necessary in the future.

**The proponent shall incorporate the following mitigation measures into the project:**

1. If at any time as a result of project activities, fish are observed in distress, a fish kill occurs, or water quality problems develop, operations shall cease.
2. Work shall not resume until further approval is given by the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife.
