MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: POMONA VIEW MOBILE PARK – GRASS CARP – PRIVATE POND

Description of Proposal: Plant triploid (sterile) grass carp into an unnamed pond, with no public access, to control aquatic vegetation. Future restocking may be necessary due to fish loss.

The proponent shall incorporate the following mitigation measures into the project:

1. All inlets and/or outlets shall be fully screened prior to planting grass carp to prevent fish from emigrating out of the pond.
2. Screens must be well-designed and durable.
3. After installation, applicant must have screen inspection by WDFW prior to stocking fish.
4. Screens need to be maintained and replaced if necessary, as long as fish will be stocked in the pond.
5. If possible, shade trees should be planted around pond to reduce aquatic vegetation growth.


