**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Name of Proposal:** LUCAS SLOUGH ROAD ABANDONMENT PROJECT

**Description of Proposal:** Proponent plans on abandoning an old logging access road that currently has unauthorized vehicle access through a recently completed Nature Conservancy restoration planting. The project would remove the illegal fill and return the channel bottom to its original elevation. The fill would be placed to form two berms on either side of the channel. The road would be ripped and replanted with native vegetation. Barrier rock would be placed at several locations to prevent entry.
