Description of DNS: Improve existing boat launch facility on the Sammamish River. Project includes placement of 1,856sf of enhancement gravels and 500sf of shoreline planting of native willow species as habitat restoration

The lead agency is providing updated information on this project which may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The updated information provided below does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

The original environmental checklist dated February 2, 2004, should be modified to reflect the following changes:

Section A- Background-#11

Project Impacts and Mitigation/Conservation Measures.

Second paragraph is amended to:

Mitigation of impacts to the Sammamish River would increase some stream, stormwater, and biological support functions at the mitigation site (see Section 7 of this report). Proposed shoreline enhancements would provide a greater projected improvement over functions evaluated in the baseline study. Mitigated riverbed and shoreline environment would have a net gain in functional units. ~~NOAA fisheries has reviewed and supports this mitigation plan for the enhancement of fish habitat in the Sammamish River. Kitty Nelson of NOAA Fisheries has visited the site to review the mitigation proposal and has endorsed the mitigation plan based on its benefit to fish habitat in the Sammamish River~~

Based on the original environmental checklist and the updated information provided in this addendum, the lead agency has determined that a new threshold determination is not warranted. There is no comment period associated with this SEPA environmental checklist addendum.
