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DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: DUNGENESS RIVER CHINOOK SALMON SUPPLEMENTATION PROJECT

Description of Proposal: Operate a portable fish trap at the mouth of the Hatchery outlet creek. This trap is 3' high, 8' long and 5' wide. An optional wing may be used that is 3' high and 8' long. A second portable trap of same dimensions would be operated at various locations on the river. A circular hoop trap that is 10' tall and 20' long would be placed in the river at the hatchery and may be fished in the lower river if needed. All traps will be checked twice daily and pulled out of the river during high water events.

Location of Proposal, including street, if any: Dungeness Hatchery, 1261 Fish Hatchery Road, Sequim, Washington, Clallam County; Section 12, 1 and/or 2, Township 30 North, Range 04 West WM Another portable trap may be operated in the river downstream from the hatchery in Section 35, 26, 23, 14, 11, 02, Township 31 North, Range 03 and 04 West WM.
