**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Name of Proposal:** ROUTINE MAINTENANCE AND MINOR REPAIR ACTIVITIES AT WASHINGTON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE AGENCY DAMS STATEWIDE

**Description of Proposal:** With this proposal the Department of Fish and Wildlife (DFW) will conduct routine maintenance and minor repair activities required to facilitate inspection and to maintain the structure of agency owned or leased dams (list attached) as well as dams the DFW may come to own, lease or manage in the future in accordance with WAC 173-1745-210. Routine maintenance and minor repairs include vegetation control, wildlife damage control, clearing of structures, lake level manipulation, and repairs to dam surfaces and structures. In addition to obtaining all required permits from federal, state, and local agencies, all maintenance activities will occur with notification, coordination, and concurrence with appropriate federal, state, local jurisdictions including USFWS and NOAA Fisheries Biologists, Wildlife Area Managers, Area Habitat Biologists, WDFW District Wildlife and Fisheries Biologists, DOE Dam Safety Office staff, staff from affected Counties and municipalities as well as affected adjacent landowners.
