Name of Proposal: WHITMAN LAKE ACCESS RAMP UPGRADE

Description of Proposal: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) plans to install a concrete boat ramp over an existing gravel boat ramp at Whitman Lake access area. The project includes the replacement of an old toilet with an ADA accessible vault toilet. A hog wire fence will be removed and a new chain link fencing relocated to the property line to the west.
