DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: LANGSDORF LANDING ACCESS RAMP UPGRADE

Description of Proposal: WDFW proposes to expand the existing public boat launch to better accommodate recreational boating access to Caterpillar Slough. The existing 12 ft. X 116 ft. ramp will be replaced and extended 12 ft. to allow for launching at lower tidal levels within the slough. Thirty-two (32) 12 ft. X 4 ft. X 6 inch prefabricated concrete planks will be required to extend the ramp to the required length. Cabled concrete, 48 ft. long X 4 ft. wide will be placed on either side of the lower 1/3 of the ramp to protect ramp from erosion.
