USFS will burn federal land along with State Land in the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife, 1049 Port Way, Clarkston, Washington 99403 area for fuels reduction and reinvigoration of winter range for elk, mule deer, and bighorn sheep. ~~UWSEF~~ USFS personnel will initiate and perform the burn with support from WDFW wildlife area staff.
