Name of DNS: REMODEL AND MINOR ALTERATIONS RELATED TO MITIGATION ACTIVITIES FOR PIER AT LAKE MCMURRAY

Description of DNS: Project is to remodel and alter a pier built at Lake McMurray, incorporating certain mitigation measures which include: placement of footing for ramp landward ordinary-high-water-mark, removal and replacement of creosote treated wood; modification of decking to allow greater light penetration; and compensatory mitigation which involves removal of adjacent existing pilings.

Project Description:

Project is to remove and replace a ramp, walkway, and pier built at Lake McMurray, incorporating certain mitigation measures which include: placement of footing for ramp landward ordinary-high-water-mark, removal and replacement of creosote treated wood; modification of decking to allow greater light penetration; and replacement of the pier with a smaller floating dock held in place by two new 2-inch steel pilings.

Based on the original environmental checklist and the updated information provided in this addendum, the lead agency has determined that a new threshold determination is not warranted. There is no comment period associated with this SEPA environmental checklist addendum.
