REVISED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Name of Proposal: MCKENNA FOREST RESERVE-GRASSCARP-TULE LAKE

Description of Proposal: Plant triploid (sterile) grass carp into Tule Lake, with no public access, to control aquatic vegetation. Future restocking may be necessary due to fish loss.

Environmental Document Revision:

Based upon an evaluation of new information that was brought to our attention during the comment period the proponent shall incorporate the following mitigation measures into the project:

1. All inlets and/or outlets shall be fully screened prior to planting grass carp to prevent fish from emigrating out of the pond.
