**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Name of Proposal:** BEACH SAND MINING FOR CRANBERRY BOGS

**Description of Proposal:** Annual excavation of up to 400 cubic yards of sand for cranberry bog use. Proposal is subject to permit conditions set forth in Pacific County Exemption from Shoreline Management Act Substantial Development permit, which expires December 7, 2007 and must be reapplied for annually, and Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife Hydraulic Project Approval (HPA) permit for the protection of fishlife, which expires in five years and must be reapplied for.
