DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: NILSON- GRASSCARP-PRIVATE POND

Description of Proposal: Plant triploid (sterile) grass carp into private pond, with no public access, to control aquatic vegetation. Future restocking may be necessary due to fish loss.
