DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: HUMPTULIPS HATCHERY 2009 FLOOD DAMAGE REPAIR

Description of Proposal:

This project will install 5.19 cubic yards of gravel at the intake piping area to replace gravel that was damaged in the flood event. This area is measured .33 feet deep over 12 foot slope at a distance of 35 lineal feet.

Riprap (116.67 Cubic Yards) will be placed at the Hatchery to repair the intake area. This area was damaged in an area measuring 105 feet long with a 16 foot slope distance x 1.5 feet deep.

Location of Proposal, including street, if any: Humptulips Hatchery, Humptulips, Washington, Grays Harbor County; Section 12, Township 20 North, Range 11 West WM
From Highway 101 turn onto Kirkpatrick road, located by the town of Humptulips. The Kirkpatrick Road turns into Copalis Crossing Road, approximately 57.7 yards SW of Kirkpatrick Road. The Humptulips Hatchery is located on the Copalis Crossing Road. Latitude 47.23148
Longitude -123.98512.

Lead Agency: Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW)

WDFW has determined that this proposal will likely not have a significant adverse impact on the environment. Therefore, state law¹ does not require an environmental impact statement (EIS). WDFW made this determination of nonsignificance (DNS) after we reviewed the environmental checklist and other information on file with us.
