Hello Terri, in response to your comment letter concerning the Sacheen Lake Boat Ramp and Access Renovation SEPA, I would like to confirm WDFW's intention of following Ecology requirements concerning this project. Specifically;

1. Erosion and sediment controls will be in place using the Eastern Washington Stormwater Manual recommendations.
2. No waste discharge is anticipated however a 401 Water Quality Certification will be applied for.
3. A stormwater pollution plan will be developed by engineering staff with sediment and erosion control methods implemented before construction.
4. Construction debris will be hauled offsite to an approved upland dumpsite.
5. The construction area is less than 1 acre, but if any changes are made to the scope of the project this will be reassessed.
6. Routine inspections of erosion and sediment control BMP's will be made during construction.
