**ADDENDUM TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE
DATED: November 15, 2012**

Name of DNS: # 12-080 SUMMIT LAKE ACCESS AREA IMPROVEMENTS

Description of DNS: This project includes the removal of two existing degraded boat ramps. New WDFW standard boat ramp planks will be installed in the same locations. A new ADA compliant vault toilet will be added south of the ADA parking stalls. An 18" culvert will be replaced with a 36" culvert under the entryway as maintenance. Asphalt overlay will be placed in paved areas.

WDFW is providing updated information on this project that may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The updated information provided below does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

- 1) The stream was discovered to be fish bearing and therefore the 18' culvert will be replaced by a 72 inch culvert. Gravel will be installed inside the culvert.
- 2) An existing culvert will be replaced with an outlet to the lake.
- 3) If water is flowing at the time of construction, the water will be diverted and fish screens placed to prevent passage through the work area.

Based on the original environmental checklist and the updated information provided in this addendum, we have determined that a new threshold determination is not warranted. There is no comment period associated with this SEPA environmental checklist addendum.
