Ms. Mendoza,

Thank you for your comments on the Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) Haven Lake Access Culvert Replacement project (SEPA number 13-0618). We offer the following responses to your comments:

Toxics Cleanup: If contamination is suspected, discovered, or occurs during construction, WDFW will test potentially contaminated media. If contamination of soil or groundwater is readily apparent or is revealed by testing, WDFW will notify Ecology.

Water Quality: WDFW understands that any discharge of sediment-laden runoff or other pollutants to waters of the state violate Chapter 90.48 RCW and WAC 173-201A and that these actions are subject to enforcement action. Erosion control methods will be in place prior to any clearing, grading, or construction on the site and will be effective to prevent stormwater runoff from carrying soil and other pollutants into waters of the state. All construction debris will be placed outside of the flood zone where the debris cannot enter waters of the state.
