Floodplain Management

No work is proposed within the Cowlitz County regulated floodway for the proposed Kalama Falls Hatchery renovation project. Required Cowlitz County permits will be obtained for working in the floodplain, including a Cowlitz County floodplain review. This floodplain review is part of the Substantial Development review process.

Shorelands and Environmental Assistance

All required Cowlitz County permits will be obtained for the Kalama Falls Hatchery renovation project through the Major Development permit review process, including any conditional use permits, if required.

Waste 2 Resources

Clean gravel will be used during fill activities. A Southwest Washington Clean Air permit will be obtained as required for demolition activities for this project. If required, any Cowlitz County health permits pertaining to the Kalama Falls Hatchery renovation project will be obtained.
