We are in favor of the beaver dam removal on Fazon Lake located in Whatcom County. We also support ongoing and future cleaning, maintenance, and rehabilitation of drainage outlets from the lake.

Our property fronts the lake on the south side, north of Hemmi Road. Over the last 2 years water levels in the lake have been noticeably higher than normal. The high level is having a detrimental effect on our 600+ blueberry bushes that were established more than 50 years ago and that we continue to maintain and harvest. Our pasture land, also established decades ago, is much softer and wetter, shortening the summertime grazing period available to a few horses and/or cattle.
