ADDENDUM TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE AND ADDENDUM DATED: September 12, 2012 and February 25, 2013.

Name of DNS: WDFW LANGSDORF ACCESS RAMP & SITE UPGRADE DNS #12-063
and Addendum #13-019.

Description of DNS 12-063:

This project replaces an existing boat ramp, installs a float alongside the boat ramp and a toilet, paves a graveled parking area next to the boat ramp, and resurfaces a gravel parking area across the street from the boat launch. An ADA accessible parking area, sidewalks and a loading ramp will be installed near the boat ramp, along with an informational kiosk. The Shillapoo Wildlife Area across the road will have parking lot expanded and also paved.

Description of DNS Addendum 13-019:

Specific Changes are inserted in the enclosed SEPA checklist (yellow highlight):

- The project is still installing a float, however the float design now uses improved light penetrating standards and an all aluminum base, instead of (Port Orford Cedar).
- The Shillapoo Wildlife area parking lot will not be paved. The only part of the project that will be paved is next to the boat ramp, the Shillapoo Wildlife area will be regraded and resurfaced with gravel materials.
- Additions include
 - two bioswales (one on each side of the roadway), specialized plants for each bioswale
 - Installation of LWD along the Columbia River area down from the boat ramp.

Location of DNS, including street, if any: WDFW Langsdorf Boat Access Area and Shillapoo Wildlife Area, Washington, Clark County; Section 36, Township 03 North, Range 01 East WM

Note: Floodplain mitigation would be in Section 31.

WDFW is providing updated information on this project that may be of interest to other agencies or the public. The updated information provided below does not substantially change the analysis of significant impacts in the existing environmental checklist.

The original environmental checklists dated September 14, 2012 and dated February 25, 2013, should be modified to reflect the following change (Changes in the checklist are highlighted in blue.):

Flood Plain Mitigation for Langsdorf Boat launch and site upgrade:

The proposed project includes a flood plain storage area that will be excavated across the Shillapoo Wildlife Area, east of the proposed boat ramp.

Cross sectional calculations yield a net cut of 1,286 cubic yards of material to be hauled off site to an approved disposal facility.

The fill removed includes a berm of old silage material, and an area of concrete floor that used to be part of a foundation for a building that is no longer present. The site is located on the Shillapoo Wildlife Area. This area is accessed by a gravel road entering at the main Shillapoo Wildlife Area entrance, and located at (45.698586,-122.733339) **It is located in Section 31, Township 03 North, Range 01 East in Clark County.**

This floodplain storage area is located at an old farm silage storage facility. The site is within the 100 year BFE per FIRM panel 278. We will remove the center berm and grade the sides to a 2h:1v slopes. The site will be seeded with matching pasture grasses.

Based on the original environmental checklist and the updated information provided in this addendum, we have determined that a new threshold determination is not warranted. There is no comment period associated with this SEPA environmental checklist addendum.
