### Statement of Significance:

**Description of Physical Appearance:** The dwelling was built in the first half of the 1900's. The structure has been added onto over time. This is a 1-1/2 story with irregular shape and dimensions. Ground floor is 896 square feet. Upstairs provides an added area of 360+/- square feet. Parts of the foundation are concrete, others undetermined. The foundation is not continuous. The exterior walls and roof are sheathed with colored metal. The interior has been extensively remodeled with newer cabinetry, paneling and flooring. Windows are thermal-pane design. A simple 22 foot x 20 foot wood frame garage is situated near the Bear Creek Road. It has a metal roof and wood siding. It is in fair condition. A number of small wooden outbuildings are present; however, they are in poor condition overall.




