DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

Name of Proposal: DNS 14-006: CLEAR LAKE ACCESS IMPROVEMENT - TOILETS
Description of Proposal:

This project includes the removal existing toilets and replacement with new ADA compliant vault toilets. The current vault toilet structure and vault will be cleaned and removed. Minor grading (less than 5 CY) may be required for siting the new vault toilet. The footprint when the new toilet is installed will be about the same size as the current toilet.

The addition of the asphalt accessible parking pad will convert some grass and gravel to impervious surface. This results in a total area of 603 square feet. The parking site is 5.17 acres and will only have one apron paved. All three road entrance aprons will be paved over gravel, totaling 2,267 square feet of road apron paving.

A second part of the project at the same property has not yet been permitted but will follow shortly: two boat ramps will be replaced with a single ramp and articulated concrete mats. Due to permitting time constraints, the projects will be treated separately.


