**ADDENDUM 14-051 TO FINAL SUPPLEMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT
STATEMENTS**

Name of FSEIS:

1. Lake and Stream Rehabilitations Final Supplemental Impact Statement (FSEIS), 1992-1993 and
2. Lake and Stream Rehabilitation: Rotenone Use and Health Risks FSEIS, 2002

Description of Proposal:

The original FSEISs were reviewed as a statewide proposal. Implementation of the FSEISs include the following lakes for the **2014** season.

Rehabilitation of two lake systems in eastern Washington (Columbia National Wildlife Chain of 13 Lakes in Grant County and McDowell Lake in Stevens County), by the use of Rotenone, to improve fishing opportunity in trout-only managed lakes by elimination of competitor species of fish. It will also restore the economic strategy of stocking fingerling trout instead of the much more expensive, large "catchables". It also improves water quality and wildlife habitat by removing Common Carp. Rainbow Trout will be restocked in the spring of 2015.

The competing species of fish in this year's projects include pumpkinseed sunfish in the Grant County lakes and Tench in McDowell Lake. Their presence in these lakes is likely a result of either illegal stocking or downstream movement from waters above them in the connected water system.

McDowell Lake – Sections 6, 7, and 8, Township 34 North, Range 41 East.
