Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the mitigated determination of nonsignificance for the Indian Creek Floodplain Restoration project. We have reviewed the environmental checklist and have the following comments.

SHORELANDS/ENVIRONMENTAL ASSISTANCE

Ecology may have a 401 water quality certification to issue in response to the Corps of Engineers Nationwide permit. Information that should be presented with the JARPA documents includes the location of staging and access areas, wetland areas that could be impacted by construction and staging activities, and vegetation/restoration strategies. In addition, a narrative describing the BMPs that will be used to prevent or minimize turbidity discharges during construction should be included in the JARPA documentation.
