ADDENDUM 15-006 TO DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE 12-080 DATED: NOVEMBER 15, 2012

Name of DNS: 12-080 SUMMIT LAKE ACCESS AREA IMPROVEMENTS

Description of Original Proposal:

This project includes the removal of two existing degraded boat ramps. New WDFW standard boat ramp planks will be installed in the same locations. A new ADA compliant vault toilet will be added south of the ADA parking stalls. An 18" culvert will be replaced with a 36" culvert under the entryway as maintenance. Asphalt overlay will be placed in paved areas.

Addendum 13-014 dated February 5, 2013:

- 1) The stream was discovered to be fish bearing and therefore the 18' culvert will be replaced by a 72 inch culvert. Gravel will be installed inside the culvert.
- 2) An existing culvert will be replaced with an outlet to the lake.
- 3) If water is flowing at the time of construction, the water will be diverted and fish screens placed to prevent passage through the work area.

Description of the Addendum:

After the modifications outlined in the SEPA checklist were complete, a scour hole formed along the north and west sides of the western-most ramp. WDFW proposes adding articulated concrete matting to this corner to further protect the ramp. The northern articulated concrete mat will measure 8' by 16' and will be placed at the end of the ramp. The western mat will measure 4' by 16' and will be added to the shoulder of the ramp. This modification will add to the longevity of the project and reduce maintenance in the future. It will also be useful to access site users since this will eliminate the hazard created by the scour. Only one ramp will be closed during work and the work will be completed in a timely manner to reduce the impact to the environment and to recreational uses. A silt curtain will be placed around the ramp to reduce sediment impact in the water. No other work will be conducted at this time.
