Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Determination of Nonsignificance regarding the proposal to grade and resurface the vehicle maneuvering area and install a concrete abutment, install a new float, construct ADA car and trailer parking stalls and provide a walkway for ADA Access to the float from the parking area (Proponent-Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife ). The Department of Ecology has reviewed the documents and submits the following comments:

Shorelands and Environmental Assistance Program-Wetlands

Section 401 Water Quality Certification will be required from the Department of Ecology in conjunction with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers' permit for this project. Project activities cannot impact the delineated wetland or wetland buffer (setback area). If project plans change which may result in wetland or buffer impacts, the appropriate local, state, and federal permits must be obtained and a mitigation plan must be prepared.
