Thank you for your comments regarding the Pacific County Access Maintenance Projects.
Responses to Ecology's comments are:

Contamination is not suspected, but if it is discovered, or occurs during the proposed boat ramp replacements, testing of the potentially contaminated media will be conducted. If contamination of sediment, soil, or groundwater is readily apparent, or is revealed by testing, Ecology will be notified.

Erosion control measures will be in place prior to any clearing, grading, or construction. These control measures will be effective to prevent stormwater runoff from carrying soil and other pollutants into surface water or stormdrains that lead to waters of the state.

We appreciate your review of the projects and look forward to working with you on this and future projects.
