Hi Todd/Dan,

The legal description for LeClerc (T35N, R43E, Sec 12; T35N, R44E, Sec 6) is correct.

I'll admit to being new and also confused on the naming conventions of the wildlife areas. Administratively, these units are run by Daro Palmer who manages Sherman Creek Wildlife Area. However, the Rustlers Gulch and LeClerc "units", managed under the Sherman Creek Wildlife Area, are sometimes called "wildlife areas" on their own. We have the same situation on the Blue Mountain Wildlife Areas. For instance, administratively, Grouse Flats is sometimes called Grouse Flats Wildlife Area, and sometimes designated a "unit" of the Chief Joseph Wildlife Area.

If the language is confusing, please feel free to drop "Sherman Creek WA" and just write LeClerc Wildlife Area.
