Thank you for contacting the Washington State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) and Department of Archaeology and Historic Preservation (DAHP) regarding the above referenced proposal. We have reviewed the materials you provided for this project. The SEPA documents state that a cultural resources survey was completed for this project “in September of 2015 to identify and evaluate cultural resources. A report was sent to the Office of Archaeology and Historic Preservation. There were no cultural resources noted during this investigation.”

In order to complete our review we request the following material to be provided to our office:

- We have not received the cultural resources survey referenced above. Please forward the survey to us for review. Given the recorded archaeological resources and human burials in the vicinity as well as high probability of the landform for containing additional such resources we would agree that a professional archaeological survey is warranted.
