Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the Determination of Nonsignificance regarding the proposal to develop a 900-acre shooting preserve for the safe hunting of game birds (Proponent: R. Jason Olmstead). The Department of Ecology (Ecology) has reviewed the documents and submits the following comments:

Water Resources Program

Any surface water diversions will require application to the Department of Ecology for a water right permit.

Any ground water development proposal that will withdraw water in excess of 5,000 gallons per day for single or group domestic supply, or for industrial purposes, or for the irrigation of more than ½ acre of lawn or non-commercial garden will require a permit from the Department of Ecology.
