

REPORTING

As per WAC 232-36-065(4), the holder of a WCO permit will maintain current activity records as required by WDFW.

All wildlife taken under the authority of a WCO permit will be reported to WDFW.

Nuisance Wildlife Reports are to be submitted annually and must include the year reported, WCO name or business, address, and telephone number. In addition, reports will document each nuisance wildlife complaint received with the following information.

- 1.) Date of complaint
- 2.) Location of problem
- 3.) County of complainant
- 4.) Species of wildlife causing the complaint
- 5.) Number of animal captured
- 6.) Disposition of complaint: R= Released, E=Euthanized, I=Information, or O=Other (explanation)

Annual nuisance wildlife report must be received by the WDFW Enforcement Program Office no later than April 20 of each year.

All records and wildlife in possession of WCO's and/or business with WCO permits shall be available for inspection by a Fish and Wildlife Officer or other WDFW employee at any reasonable time.
