From Sedro Woolley, head east on Highway 20 for approximately 9.8 miles to Cabin Cr Road. Turn left and go 0.1 miles to the Hamilton Cemetary Road. Turn right and go 0.2 miles to the second left or HO 1000 mainline. Turn left and go approximately 1.1 miles to a fork, stay right and continue until you first cross the West Fork of Alder Creek, then continue on until you come to a bridge on the East Fork of Alder Creek . Park here and hike down stream approximately 0.2 miles to the site.

Area Overview :

Site is a very small wall-based channel originating out of a swampy wet area fed by wall-based seeps. This site provides a very small amount of over-winter habitat for a hand full of fish.






