SUBSTRATE TYPE: Silt. Some gravel in old side channel (i.e. the lower 130 m of the channel).

SITE SIZE: **Length-** 230 m
 Width- Surface = 3 to 4 ft
 Channel = 6 to 10ft
 Depth- 8 to 10 inches

WATER SOURCE: Springs.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Follow directions to site B-L3-06 then walk upstream along the river bank and past B-L3-07 to B-L3-08 (see overview and site direction maps).

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No fish observed. Channel appears to have an excellent egress & fish should have unrestricted access.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Moderate.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time.

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: The upper 80 to 100 m of B-L3-08 is a spring channel. The lower 130 m is an old inactive overflow channel of the Bogachiel River. The channel is well vegetated and there is no indication of recent flooding. The site has poor access for machinery and/or materials. Present flows are probably above average due to recent rains.

The spring was flowing at a trickle and had a temp. of 43 F, but went subsurface a short way down the channel.
