WATER SOURCE: Small seep springs and a small valley wall trib.


DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Traveling north on Hwy 101 turn left just beyond MP 185 onto the G-2000. Follow the G-2000 approx. 6 miles to the G-2600. A landing at the end of the G-2600 overlooks the Dry Creek drainage. Hike down Dry Cr. to the river, then downstream from the mouth of Dry Creek to B-L4-05 (see site and site direction maps).

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: Fish have access to, and are currently utilizing, the wetted portions of the channel. Three fish were seen in a small pool.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Mod. to high potential for backwater flooding.



LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time.


COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: Even though fish were seen in the channel, B-L4-05 does not appear to offer much in the way of reliable, long-term winter rearing habitat. The water in B-L4-05 lacks both depth and volume. It seems likely that the channel will completely dry up during winter dry spells and so act as a death trap for any fish that move into it. The upper and lower 80 m of the channel contained a small amount of running water. However, the middle reaches had only intermittent water. It appears that a slide recently occurred near the upper end of the channel leaving it inundated with mud.
