
DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Head north on Hwy 101 to the city of Forks. Proceed to the downtown area and turn left (west) onto Bogachiel Way (just past Pay & Save Grocery). Stay on Bogachiel Way about 3 mi. until coming to the W.D.W. steelhead rearing pond. Drive along the north bank to the lower end of the pond. Stay right and follow the road up the hill toward the Rayonier Calawah Rearing Ponds. Bear right and go to the north pond (i.e. C-L1-04). Walk down to the confluence of the north pond egress and the Calawah River. Walk downstream along the LB of the river. The first channel is C-L1-03 the second channel is C-L1-02.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: One fry was observed in C-L1-02. The channel has a good egress into a deep glide. Water in the channel goes subsurface at the mouth, but appears that the fry can swim through. One fry was observed in the channel.


FLOODING POTENTIAL: Moderate from back water flooding during high flows. Upper end is protected.

LANDOWNER: Unknown

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: C-L1-02 is a deeply incised (8 - 12 ft) channel. There is very little slack water for rearing. C-L1-02 would make a better rearing and refuge area if it were deeper and wider. Recommend controls for pooling water.
