
**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** Head north on Hwy 101 to the city of Forks. Proceed to the downtown area and the turn left (west) onto Bogachiel Way (just past Pay & Save Grocery). Stay on Bogachiel Way about 3 mi. until coming to the W.D.W. steelhead rearing pond. Drive along the north bank to the lower end of the pond. Stay right and follow a road up the hill toward the Rayonier Calawah Rearing Ponds. Bear right and go to the north pond (i.e. C-L1-04). Walk down to the confluence of the north pond egress and the Calawah River. Walk downstream along the LB of the river to the mouth of C-L1-03.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** No fry were observed in C-L1-03. The channel has a good egress into a deep glide. There is a moderate gradient at the mouth, but it appears fry can swim up through it.


**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** Moderate for back water flooding. Upper end seems protected.

**LANDOWNER:** Unknown at this time.

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** C-L1-03 is a small spring fed stream with two small tribs. It has a moderately gentle gradient throughout. Installation of controls could enhance this trib. C-L1-03 has an excellent egress into the same eddy as North Pond (see C-L1-04). Since the North Pond Channel is not always available there is good potential for this trib. Recommend installing controls to create more pool habitat.
