Describe pond and other rearing habitat: This site is low gradient, shallow and slow-moving. It has a very mucky substrate and is loaded with water parsley in places. It flows through a hardwood lowland area and has a good amount of brushy cover with salmonberry being the most common. It originates along side an old railroad grade as water seeps out of the ground at the base of a draw that is dry.






