
DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Head north on Highway 101. Take first right north of mile post 156. Then see attached map.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No fish were observed. At low to moderate river flows the mouth would be difficult for fish to find. Seems doubtful that fish use this channel.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low. Some backwater flooding probably occurs.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time. Probably ITT Rayonier.

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: This small trib enters the Clearwater River at a glide. The water conditions at the glide would probably allow fish to find their way into the channel. A log at the mouth of the channel, however, appears to inhibit upstream migration. The lower 50 m of CW-R3-02 is deeply incised and contains excessive amounts of woody debris in places. The banks of the channel are densely vegetated with salmonberry and salal. CW-R3-02 probably dries up early in the summer.
