**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** Head north on Hwy 101. Turn right onto the K-1000 Rd approx. 0.5 miles north of Kalaloch. Then see site direction map.  
(An alternate route via the C-2100 is also available. See CW-R4-02.)

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** No fish were observed. Moderately steep gradient would appear to limit extensive coho use.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** Low.

**LANDOWNER:** Unknown at this time.

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** This trib was identified in Peterson's survey as a "possible" enhancement site. Entering the Clearwater R. at a fast riffle, this trib is about the size of Dismal Creek (20.0461) on the Hoh River. A series of cascades at the mouth are probably covered during high winter flows but otherwise appear to limit the upstream migration of juvenile coho. There is enough gravel in places to allow for limited spawning. The pools and tailouts are very small, however. Rearing and overwintering habitat is very limited. Habitat improvements do not appear feasible.




