DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Head north from Forks on Hwy 101. Turn left just beyond mp 193 (1.0 mi. north of Forks) onto the La Push Rd. Proceed west on La Push Rd about 3.1 miles. Turn right onto the Quillayute Rd. and continue west for 4.0 mi. Turn right onto Mina Smith Rd. (at Quillayute Cemetery) and proceed north about 0.8 mi. (crossing the Colby Creek Bridge) to the D-5000 intersection. Continue on the Mina Smith Rd. (the D-5200) for about 1.0 mi. The road crosses numbered trib. 20.0107. Just past the second road to the right is D-L3-05. The channel runs parallel to the east side of the road for about 150 m.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: Fish appear to have access only on higher flows due to a culvert on the D-5200. No fish were observed.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time (possibly ITT Rayonier and others).

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: D-L3-05 appears to have very limited use in its present condition. The mouth of the channel has good entrance conditions. 10 m above the mouth, however, the channel has a steep gradient up to the culvert at the D-5200. This appears to create a passage problem at normal winter flows. Above the culvert, D-L3-05 has a gentle gradient and the channel widens into a small marsh. Flows appear to remain fairly steady during low flow periods. Excess woody debris was seen in the upper third of the channel.

D-L3-05 appears to have the potential to be deepened and/or beaded in order to create a fall planting site.



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

This site has the potential for some controls below culvert and above road. This would create habitat for fall plants. Not much else could be done here.




RIVER: DICKEY
