SITE SIZE: **Length-** 820 m (includes trib.)
 Width- Water surface = 50 cm - 1 m
 Channel = 60 cm - 3 m
 Depth- 10 - 25 cm Max = 50 cm

WATER SOURCE: Springs and terrace tributary.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Go north of Forks on Hwy 101 about 3.1 mi. Turn left (west) 0.1 mi. past MP 195 onto the D-2000. Proceed west about 2.9 mi. to the D-4000. Turn left onto the D-4000 and proceed 2.0 miles to the jct. with the D-2200. Continue on the D-4000 (unimproved grade) about 50 m. This grade parallels the upper reach of ED-114R-06. (Note: No turn arounds are found along this grade. You must back out or drive through to the RY-5000).


FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No fry were observed. This stream has an excellent entrance and a low gradient. There are no apparent restrictions to fish access and no reason why fish shouldn't utilize it.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time (probably DNR).

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: ED-114R-06 begins on an intermediate terrace in a 20 to 40 year old alder and conifer forest. It maintains a relatively low gradient throughout.

Installation of controls will enhance existing winter rearing habitat in both ED-114R-06 and its tributary.
