SUBSTRATE TYPE: Mostly sand. Some gravel.

SITE SIZE: **Length-** About 600 m from mouth to Upper Hoh Rd. (Estimated from aerial photo)
 Width- 1 ft
 Depth- 0.5- 1.0 inches

WATER SOURCE: Surface run off and a small amount of spring water.

DIRECTIONS TO SITE: North on Hwy 101. Turn right between mile post 178 & 179 onto the Upper Hoh Road. Follow this road until coming to the Westward Hoh Resort (about 6 mi.). Continue east crossing the Rock Cr. and Tower Cr. bridges. The road enters a large, flat clear-cut area about 1 mi. east of Tower Cr. Take the first right after entering this clearcut. This short spur road crosses H-R12-01 (via a culvert) 0.1 to 0.2 miles south of the Upper Hoh Rd.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No fish observed. Juvenile coho have access to the lower few feet of the channel. The gradient becomes impassible a short distance above the mouth and the channel goes dry.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time.

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: Surface water was seen only in the extreme lower reaches of H-R12-01. An impassible gradient occurs a short way above the mouth. The gradient moderates as the channel reaches the first terrace above the Hoh flood plain. H-R12-01 appears to maintain a useable surface flow in its mid and upper reaches only during periods of heavy rain-fall. The mid to upper reaches of H-R12-01 are currently being logged. The lower reaches have been logged and burned in the recent past.

Five minnow traps where set in this channel to see if Coho are using this part of the channel.


The minnow traps where baited with salmon roe and placed throughout the stream. No fish where caught.

Upper Hoh Rd




Site: H-R12
