DIRECTIONS TO SITE: Head north on Hwy 101. Turn right at mile post 176 onto the Hoh Mainline. Turn left just prior to mile post 7.0 onto the H-1000. Follow the H-1000 about 2.4 miles to a major fork. Stay to the left at this fork as if going to the Fletcher Ranch. Follow the H-1060 (paralleling Owl Creek) about 1.5 miles until the road T's. Turn right at the T, crossing the Owl Creek bridge. The road crosses H-L11-02 at the second culvert (just north of the mobile home).

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: Good access and probable use by juvenile coho. No fish observed, however. Spawning may also occur here.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low flood potential upstream of the gravel driveway (200 m above the mouth).

LANDOWNER: Fletcher

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS : According to the landowner (Mrs. Fletcher) salmon used to spawn in this creek. If spawning still occurs, it is in very limited numbers. There is good gravel and no obvious reason why fish would not spawn here. A small spring fed pond is situated on the R.B. about 270 m above the mouth (see pond data supplement).


FISH ACCESS & CURRENT USE: No fish were seen. There is good access and no apparent reason why juvenile coho would not be using this pond.

TYPE & AMOUNT OF IN POND COVER: Some bank cover and overhanging bank. No woody debris or in pond cover.

COMMENTS: The springs that feed this pond also supply the domestic water for the homes on the Fletcher Ranch. When the Hoh is at flood stage some river water may enter the pond from an overflow channel. The pond is currently the home of a small flock of domestic ducks.


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
