**WATER SOURCE:** Inflow from water in old oxbow channel. Some groundwater.


**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** See site H-L2-01: A gravel road at the junction of Hwy 101 and the lower Hoh road leads to a gravel pit area. Channels H-L2-01, H-L2-02, and H-L2-03 are located mainly to the north and east of this gravel pit.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** Appears to be accessible. Some coho fry observed in upper end. No fry observed in pool area, but dark water makes observation difficult.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** Moderate.

**LANDOWNER:** Unknown at this time.

**COMMENTS & RECOMENDATIONS:** This area contains a long, wide, deep and nearly continuous pool which is some 1500 m in length and 10 - 20 m in width. It appears to range in depth from 2 - 5'. Very little perceptible flow in this pool area. Old maps indicate this channel as the lower end of Braden Creek which now appears to enter the old oxbow channel at the upper end of this site.




