DIRECTIONS TO SITE: North on Hwy 101. Turn left approximately 0.5 miles north of the Braden Creek bridge onto the G & L shake road. Continue down this road, keeping to the left at the first fork, until coming to the gravel pit area. The channels are located to the east of the pit. The channels cross the road before coming to the pit, but are poorly defined.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No apparent summer access. Winter access and utilization appears doubtful.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Appears to be rather low.

LANDOWNER: Unknown at this time.

COMMENTS & RECOMENDATIONS: The majority of the channels here do not show evidence of long term standing water. Most are well vegetated. The main channel appears to have some pooled water during the winter, but this water appears to be primarily from surface runoff. The entire H-L2-07 area is transected by a network of old skid trails.






