
DIRECTIONS TO SITE: North on Hwy 101. Right at m.p. 176 onto Hoh main -line. Turn left off mainline at m.p. 3.5. Keep right at first fork. Stay left at major fork 1.1 miles from Hoh mainline. Proceed 0.7 mi. until road makes two quick forks. Stay left at the first and right at the second. The road goes down a fairly steep grade and enters the H-L9 area 2.3 mi. from the Hoh mainline turn off. See area H-L9 map .

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No apparent access problems but not many fry were observed.

FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low.


LANDOWNER: Milwaukee Land Co., State of Wash., and possibly others.

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: This trib appears to be one of the major egress routes for water running off a large, high terrace area. The lower 300 m offers some rearing habitat, but the stream tends to become quite steep above that point.
