
DIRECTIONS TO SITE: 8 miles west on Oil city road to C.A. Anderson residence.

FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE: No fry observed in the channel above the flood plain. Stream empties into a well used eddy so it should be easy to find. There is a small falls at creek entrance that appears to inhibit fry migration.


FLOODING POTENTIAL: Low to moderate.

COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS: Channel is pretty much all sand, lots of small woody debris, and very little pooling for rearing. Could place some controls to eliminate this problem and make overwintering habitat.




