**DIRECTIONS TO SITE:** (See directions to H-R4-01: West on Oil city road to Anderson cr. bridge. Turn left on first gravel road past bridge. Follow road to end. Walk across clear cut to the left towards river. First depression is H-R4-02. Continue to next channel towards river.) This channel is located about 0.25 miles due east of 2 large spruce trees in the middle of clearcut. Alternate access is 0.4 miles east of Anderson cr. bridge via a river bar access road.

**FISH ACCESS AND CURRENT USE:** Coho fry are using the beaver pond. They are trapped in the isolated pool up the channel.

**FLOODING POTENTIAL:** High

**LANDOWNER:** Rayonier

**COMMENTS & RECOMMENDATIONS:** This is an active overflow channel. The upper half is dry except for some pools. It braids at times. In the mid section there is an isolated pool with trapped fry. About 25 m below the isolated pool is a small beaver pond with coho fry in it. The pond has a branch of it that connects to Anderson cr. allowing for clear access by fry.
